- determine the price components of any option
- · keep accurate records of profits and losses
- · calculate the probability of an option's success
- · open and close Level Two trades on thinkorswim
- · scan and sort candidate stocks
- · analyze low-, medium- and high-risk trades
- · select appropriate strategies for current market conditions
- · protect a portfolio of stocks using options
- execute Calls, Puts, Credit and Debit Spreads, Iron Condors, Strangles, Straddles and LEAPS
- · manage expiration of options and stock assignments
- · develop a track record of all trades
- complete 100 trades in thinkorswim
